
Threesomes, Foursomes, and Moresomes!




Jasmine Parr

Warrior Health Training

For therapists who may be interested in seeing more uniformed personnel and first responder clients, Insight has made an arrangement to get a discount for an occupational awareness course with <u>Warrior Health</u>. Warrior Health is a national directory of mental health care providers that offer care to uniformed personnel and first responders suffering from occupation-related trauma and issues. In order to be listed on the directory (https://warriorhealth.ca/directory), a mental health care provider must first take Warrior Health's online occupational awareness course.

Warrior Health will register our therapists at the rate of \$100 per participant (instead of \$150 per participant). If a therapist is fully willing, ready, and able to take on more uniformed personnel and first responder clients once they have taken the course and be on the Warrior Health Directory, Insight would be happy to subsidize 50% of the course fee. 
Introducing... PSYCHOWL!

After many months of collecting mental health resources, we are excited to announce that PsychOwl, our digital mental health library, is ready to launch in January!

PsychOwl was designed to help all people, including children, adults, workplaces, veterans, students etc. learn about mental health concerns and how to overcome them. PsychOwl currently has over 5000 resources, comprised of videos, worksheets, podcasts, articles and more! This tool will be free for you and your clients to access!

To search for resources you simply choose the main topic (e.g. depression), a sub-topic (e.g. post-partum depression), and the user group you are searching for (e.g. adults). Another option is using the search bar to find a specific topic (e.g. skin picking).

A unique feature of PsychOwl is that it has multiple libraries that branch off from the General library. There is a Workplace Library, which includes but is not limited to, resources on leadership, psychological safety, retirement and work-life balance. An Education Library for students and teachers of all ages who struggle with test anxiety, stress, bullying, etc. A Zen Library filled with guided meditations, mindfulness worksheets, and self-care mantras, and a Course Library with free courses for all subscribers to utilize!






